Linda Krukar of Dabney Dobermans

Linda has been involved with Doberman Pinschers for over 25 years, breeding under the prefix "Dabney". Her first show dog, the record setting fawn, Ch Amulet's Luka of Sno-Glenn CD, is found in the pedigrees of many of today's top winners and producers and is the foundation of the Dabney line. He was the first fawn in the DPCA Top 20 and a DPCA Award of Merit recipient, and sire of BIS winners. He is the grandsire of the record setting Ch Brunswig's Cryptonite, who was shown by Linda until he was a year old. Some other notable dogs owned by Linda are Ch Brunswig's Zared of Dabney CD, winner of 14 All Breed Bests in Show, a DPCA Top 20 winner and Award of Merit recipient. His son, shown by Linda, Ch Dabney's Lookout for Ledo, a group winner, has produced 30 Champions including two DPCA National Specialty winners (both owner handled), two DPCA Top 20 winners, grand prize futurity winner, and several Best in Show winners. His daughter, Ch Dabney's Hot Enchilada of Le-High, shown by Linda, was the winner of 15 All Breed BIS (her first at barely a year old), 17 BISS, DPCA National Specialty BOB and Top 20 winner, BOB at Westminster and dam of 4 Champions including the DPCA Top 20 Obedience winner and OTCH Dabney's Jose Cuervo Especial. Linda is currently showing her homebred Doberman, Ch Dabney's Phenomenon, who at four years old is the number one Doberman all systems, number two Working Dog, the 2006 DPCA Top Twenty winner, winner of 27 All Breed BIS, 36 BISS and three time DPCA Award of Merit and Westminster KC Award of Merit recipient. Linda added German Pinschers to her home, importing two dogs from Finland. Her male, Ch Clefell's Jaguar, was the first German Pinscher to finish his Championship as a puppy, and went on to win the GPCA National Specialty in 2004 and 2005. Their female was BOW at the National and their son won the National in 2006. She shows her own dogs.

Linda's involvement in dogs goes beyond the ring. She has served on the Board of Directors of the DPCA and is an active member of several All Breed Clubs. She worked for the AKC in Show Events, has given many Doberman and German Pinscher seminars and was Judge's Education Chairman and Standard Chairman for the German Pinscher Club of America. Linda believes that it's important to understand the fine points of a breed when judging. She has written "Dobermans in Detail, A commentary on the Doberman Pinscher Standard" and "The German Pinscher Illustrated" so that judges will have a better understanding of the fine points of the standard, as well as, the examination procedure for these breeds.
